This programme benefits from the financial support of the European Commission.

FUNDING OF VISITS

Interested employers' organisations affiliated to UNICE, UEAPME and CEEP wishing to apply for funding under this project can receive up to the equivalent of one return flight (ceiling of \in 550) and 2 days' daily allowance (2 x \in 149.63) to cover the costs of their visit.
